

Building Permit Review Process

In response to the concerns heard at the last Village meeting (April 16, 2007) about the need to clarify and standardize our approach to the building permit review process, the Drummond Citizen's Committee has adopted the approach recommended by the majority of Drummond residents who expressed an opinion on this issue.

The process follows:

After complying with the requirements in the Village by-laws about showing your plan to any neighbors who are immediately adjacent and across the street from you, your plan must be submitted to the Drummond Citizen's Committee.

A public meeting will then be scheduled at which any resident of the Village may attend. A notice of the meeting will be sent to all residents. A copy of your building plan will be made available for review and comment to all residents attending the meeting.

After the public meeting is held the Citizen's Committee shall meet to consider whether or not to issue a Village building permit.

We trust this process will help streamline the building permit review process and alleviate any concerns raised about ambiguities in the process.
